PRAYER OF THE DAY

Almighty God, you see that we have no power to defend ourselves. Guard and keep us both outwardly and inwardly from all adversities that may happen to the body and from all evil thoughts that may assault and hurt the soul; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

FIRST LESSON - Jeremiah 26:8-15

- ⁸ But as soon as Jeremiah finished telling all the people everything the LORD had commanded him to say, the priests, the prophets and all the people seized him and said, "You must die! ⁹ Why do you prophesy in the LORD's name that this house will be like Shiloh and this city will be desolate and deserted?" And all the people crowded around Jeremiah in the house of the LORD.
- ¹⁰ When the officials of Judah heard about these things, they went up from the royal palace to the house of the LORD and took their places at the entrance of the New Gate of the LORD's house. ¹¹ Then the priests and the prophets said to the officials and all the people, "This man should be sentenced to death because he has prophesied against this city. You have heard it with your own ears!"
- ¹² Then Jeremiah said to all the officials and all the people: "The LORD sent me to prophesy against this house and this city all the things you have heard. ¹³ Now reform your ways and your actions and obey the LORD your God. Then the LORD will relent and not bring the disaster he has pronounced against you. ¹⁴ As for me, I am in your hands; do with me whatever you think is good and right. ¹⁵ Be assured, however, that if you put me to death, you will bring the guilt of innocent blood

on yourselves and on this city and on those who live in it, for in truth the LORD has sent me to you to speak all these words in your hearing."

SECOND LESSON - Philippians 3:17—4:1

¹⁷ Join with others in following my example, brothers, and take note of those who live according to the pattern we gave you. ¹⁸ For, as I have often told you before and now say again even with tears, many live as enemies of the cross of Christ. ¹⁹ Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is on earthly things. ²⁰ But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹ who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body.



McLeod County Food Shelf



Kim's Chili Recipe – 1st Place

1 lb. ground lamb

1 tablespoon Olive Oil

1 large onion, chopped

1 green pepper, chopped

1 red pepper, chopped

1 tablespoon cumin

1 tsp Sea Salt and pepper to taste

1 - 28 oz diced tomatoes

1 small can tomato paste, I like the paste that has oregano & basil

1 tablespoon garlic

1 can of white beans, I used Baby Butter Beans

1 can of black beans, I like the Seasoned Black Beans

Brown and season meat in olive oil. Add chopped onions and peppers. Add beans, cumin, sea salt, tomatoes, garlic. Cook at medium heat until it starts to bubble. Turn down to low and cook for about an1/2 hour. Add water if you like, to get consistency you want. I also like to let sit in refrigerator overnight for flavors to mix, and then the beans do not get mushy if you don't cook for a long time. You can also add more flavorings for your taste of spices or hotness that you enjoy. You can also use Schwan's Roasted Onions and Peppers, that come in a bag, instead of using fresh peppers.

"Beth's" Chili Recipe – 2nd place

1 lb hamburger

2 cans light red kidney beans

2 cans tomato sauce/crushed tomatoes

1 dollop love

1 packet McCormicks brand chili seasoning

- Brown hamburger
- Mix in beans, love, tomatoes, seasonings.
- Heat through
- Serve with cheese, sour cream, crackers as desired

Anna's Chili Recipe – 3rd Place

1 pound hamburger

 $1\ red\ pepper\ \ and\ \ 1\ small\ red\ onion$

2 cans stewed tomatoes

1 can tomato sauce

1 small can tomato paste

2 cans pinto beans

½ tsp nutmeg

1 T. chili powder and 1 T. cumin

1/8 tsp cayenne pepper

1 T. brown sugar

Garlic salt

1 cup beef broth

Brown together hamburger, pepper, onion. Add rest of ingredients. Cook and simmer together. Add water until thickness desired.
