Stewards in God's House

"Joseph found favor in [Potiphar's] eyes and became his attendant. Potiphar put him in charge of his household, and he entrusted to [Joseph's] care everything he owned."

Joseph gives us a good example of what it means to be a steward. He owned nothing but he had responsibility over everything. And Joseph took that responsibility seriously. He gave his full attention and effort toward running Potiphar's household. Joseph paid careful attention that nothing went missing or misused. He certainly never took anything for himself. And when Potiphar's wife threw herself at Joseph, Joseph refused to even be in the same room with her. He would not betray the trust that had been given to him.

As Christians, God has entrusted us with many things. God has given us relationships that need nurture and attention. If you have children, that is a huge trust from God. Not only does God mean for you to provide for their physical needs. He also expects you to pass on the faith to the next generation. Together as a church, we have a responsibility to proclaim the gospel publicly.

God has also entrusted us as human beings to take care of the land and the creatures that live in it. Our culture has become very confused about our human place in the natural order. Some insisted that it's morally wrong to consume other creatures as food. Others want to return the land to a "natural" state. Both of these ideas come from the same philosophical source. Anti-human ideas come from Darwinism, the idea that humans are nothing more than intelligent apes, with no special status or distinction among the other animals of the world.

Christians believe that God has made us stewards of the earth and its creatures. We have the right and authority to use resources for our own benefit. This includes the right to use animals for food. These rights come with great responsibility. God also expects us to take care of the land and leave it better than we found it. God expects us to give our animals a good life and to treat them humanely when that life comes to an end. We take these responsibilities seriously, knowing that we will answer to God for how well or poorly we carried them out.

Since the world has become so confused about such basic questions, we also need to be ready to defend these ideas. Humanity has a special place in God's heart that begins and ends with Jesus. Along the way, we also have God pleasing work in caring for his creation.


Pastor's Report: We welcome two new members, Kari (Halloff) Paredes and Andrew Birkmaier. Outdoor worship is planned for Sunday July 16th. Looking ahead Ash Wednesday is February 22; Easter is April 9. Confirmation is planned for May 14th with one confirmand this year.

Treasurer's Report: Our mission goal for 2022 was \$18,000 and we received \$17,322. The 2023 Mission Commitment is set for \$18,000. With the overabundance of snow this year our plowing requirements have been extraordinarily expensive. Our expenses for plowing have greatly increased over the last few winters. Any extra money directed toward grounds maintenance can be given in the "Grounds Maintenance" envelopes.

The School Board Report: The School Board reported that basketball season is underway. We currently have 70 students enrolled. Two student teachers will be coming this spring to help our teachers. The Articles of Agreement that were first presented at the October voters meeting were again presented for approval. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the Articles of Agreement as presented.

Cemetery Board Report: The Cemetery Board reported that Dave and Donna Telecky will be again mowing the cemeteries this summer. They again would like their \$1500 we would pay them, put in the west cemetery fund. We thank them again for the wonderful job they do for us.

A discussion of planting more trees in both cemeteries, as we have recently lost some due to age and storms. The Cemetery Board will work with the council on some potential spots for trees and bring it up in a forthcoming meeting.

After voting to move forward with our building project and hiring Miller to be our architect and general contractor, the building committee has had many meetings over the last 4 months to go over design, blue prints, and materials. We are currently waiting on bids for all sub contracting work. Once all of those bids come in, the building committee will meet again and decide which bids to accept. We will then know the final cost of the project.

Builders for Christ met in early January to decide among the many projects to choose from and they *chose our project*. We will find out more information in the next month or 2 see what that entails for us and the feasibility of using them. Lutheran Association for Church Extension (L.A.C.E) has accepted our application for a loan. At 4.75%, we are well below the current market. They also have securities and investments options at 2.5%, 3%, and 3.5% which have opportunities to lower our interest rate on our loan. Purchase an investment, make money on those investments, and help the school out all at the same time. They'll take a purchase investment as low as \$25, so it's a great way for the whole family to get involved. Everyone can make a difference.

Our initial 3 year fundraiser appeal received pledges and donations of about \$1,000,000. With 1 year still to go, we are still receiving those pledges. If you have not yet donated to our project, please prayerfully consider a donation of any kind. Wouldn't be awesome to have no debt or even build the gym at the same time?

A huge thank you to all who have donated already. Keep spreading the word and excitement. Pray for a warm, dry spring so we can start building as soon as possible.


