### Feeling Unloved

Kylie screamed at her mother, "You don't care! You don't even love me! All you care about is him!" Six months earlier Kylie's 9 year old brother Toby had been diagnosed with leukemia. Since then her parents had spent every waking moment thinking about Toby's treatment and every dime trying to pay for it. In all the turmoil they had forgotten Kylie's birthday. And now her parents had just broken the news that summer camp was out of the question. Kylie stomped off to her room and slammed the door.

No doubt her parents winced as they realized the truth behind Kylie's hurtful words. They had been directing more of their time and attention toward their son rather than their daughter. That didn't excuse Kylie's tirade. But it did mean mom and dad would have to confess their own failure before they confronted Kylie about hers.

We, for the most part, have moved beyond the turbulent emotions of youth. But there remain times when we feel the same way Kylie did: neglected, abandoned, and unloved. And instead of blaming our parents, we feel tempted to aim our anger at the Lord.

But our Father in heaven has not been too busy with his other children to notice us. He was not so focused on wars in distant lands that he failed to notice the battle we were going through. Rather, as a loving and all-knowing and all-powerful Father he was giving us exactly the care and attention we needed to achieve his purposes. Our Savior God is running and timing all of history to make sure that every one of his people makes it safely to eternal life.

Trouble is, we don't know what's going on behind the scenes. We cannot fathom all the plans and knowledge of God. We only have the things that are right here in front of us. When those things are problems, pains, and sorrows we quickly start to feel as if God has stopped loving us.

Two things help us to fight and overcome that feeling: We remember the promises God has made to protect and provide for us. We remember how God kept those promises to others. This is why we gather on Sunday to worship together. This treasured time allows us to set aside the turmoil of daily life and find rest in the grace of our Savior. Word and Sacrament remind us that Jesus loves us. The encouragement and love of our fellow believers remind us that we are not in this alone. Even though we might feel neglected, abandoned, or unloved, Sunday worship shows us that none of those things are true. We have love from God that can never fail.

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:37-39
