Minnesota District Convention

Immanuel belongs to the Minnesota District of the WELS. Our District encompasses the states of Minnesota, Iowa, and Missouri. Every two years the District meets in convention to talk about the work of the church and make plans for the future. This also gives our District a chance to respond to the Synod, which meets in the odd years. This year's District Convention will take place June 7-9 at Martin Luther College in New Ulm. Each congregation of the District is invited to send a representative, a lay delegate. Pastors and male teachers also serve as delegates, if they are actively serving in a call.

Harold Plath will represent Immanuel at the Convention. Zion's delegate is Allan Duesterhoeft. Each delegate is assigned to a committee that responds to part of the report from the Synod Convention.

This year we don't have any major issues or controversies to discuss. Last year the Synod passed an initiative to start 100 missions in the next 10 years. So we will talk about how we may support that goal and help carry it out in the Minnesota District.

The Convention will hear reports about the work being done by World Missions, Home Missions, Congregational Services, and our called worker training schools. After that, we will elect leaders to serve on various boards and committees. We will also elect District leaders who will serve for the next two years. Those leaders include a President, two Vice Presidents, and a District Secretary.


The **Quarterly Voter's/ Congregational Meeting** was Tuesday, April 19, 2022.

We will again have our Summer Stangs, summer care program, starting June 6. We are very excited to be able to serve our working families year round and to provide them a safe, Christian, fun environment for their children.

Fundraising has continued for over a year now, and we have \$1,000,000 committed for our new school building! With the increase in enrollment, especially in the Preschool and Kindergarten classroom, we need to build to accommodate this growth.

The School Association is recommending, from our proposed budget, that the School Association finance the remaining cost of the building project, estimating \$1,000,000, to move ahead with the building phase. The proposed budget includes raising tuition and starting a child care program for toddlers (18 months - Preschoolaged) to pay for the loan payments without increasing the contributions from either church. The proposed budget also includes the addition of staff to accommodate our growth, again, without increasing the contributions from the churches.

Our contractor, Miller Construction, has also given us an updated floor plan and site plan as we continue to coordinate with them to make the school fit and flow on the property (prairie parcel south of the parsonage).

In the coming months, the School Association will be working with Miller Construction to get more detailed blueprints and floor plans to hone in on our designs and costs. We will meet again with our congregations at the next quarterly meeting in July to give updates on our progress, and if our plans come together, ask permission to move forward with the building phase. If our plans match God's plans, we will need to let Miller Construction know by September of 2022 to begin building in May of 2023 (9 months notice is needed).

Your continued prayers and support are greatly appreciated as we look to invest in the future of our next generation of church members and leaders as we build on the foundation of Christ!
