### Weaponized Compassion

Christians strive to be compassionate people. That means we try to help people who suffer rather than turn a cold shoulder. And this world contains plenty of suffering people for us to help. Our hearts go out to people who live in poverty, those who experience natural disasters, and people who suffer from abuse or drug addiction. We can easily imagine how we would like to be treated if we were in their shoes. However, we need to understand that compassion can also be used against us. The devil can even twist this holy thing to serve his wicked purposes.

The transgender movement calls it compassion to pretend that a male can be female or a female can be male. They call it compassion to give medications that will stop a child from developing into an adult. This leads to the compassion of gender surgery that attempts to make the person's body correspond to their feelings. If you refuse to go along with such things, you will be called unloving, hateful, and bigoted.

The Christian basis for resisting such satanic evil comes from 1 Corinthians 13:6. It says, "Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth." It is unloving to pretend that a person can change their gender or sex. Because that is not true. No surgery can change the programming of a person's DNA or the wiring of their brain. It is unloving to give puberty blocking medications to children. Because such medications cannot really pause the development of a child's body into an adult. In truth, giving those medicines to children causes damage that cannot be repaired.

God calls us to love all people, even people who hate us, even people we don't get along with. Love requires us to tell the truth. God has made all people in his image, giving us bodies and souls. All people are sinners who fall short of his glory and must turn away from sin in true repentance and faith. All people have a Savior who lived and died and rose again to give them eternal life. These truths are the foundation of our compassion. We cannot show true compassion without also telling the truth.


