There was one summer a few years backwhen the rain jist didn't come down. Alfalfa was burnin' right out in the fields the bushes and trees was brown.

Some of the folks got the pastor to call a meetin' to pray fer rain. They met on a Sunday, right after church, in the orchard, next to the lane.

There was people come from all around, concerned fer the lack of water. Just plain folks like Jimmy McKay, and Louella, his little daughter.

When they arrived, some laughed at the girl, what she carried caused others t'stare. But she was a smart little 5-year-old, an' pretended that she didn't care.

Folks was millin' around a tryin' to findsome shade 'neath the old apple trees. Everyone sung hymns, then the pastor said, "Let's all git down on our knees."

For some of 'em there who'd got dressed up his idea just didn't appeal. Oh, there was some chairs fer the older folks, but everyone else had t'kneel. The pastor spoke his word, an' asked others to, includin' Louella McKay. But an elder objected, an' said real loud, "Why you askin' this child t'pray?"

The pastor said, "Well, we're prayin' for rain, but only Jimmy's Louella, of alla the folks that're gathered here, had the faith t'bring her umbrella.

Little Luella shows us what Jesus meant when he said, "whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours." (Mark 11:24) With the faith of a child she understood that if you go to pray for rain, you'd better be prepared for God to say "yes."

How many times do we ask God for things but only prepare for him to say "no"? How many times do we express surprise when God says "yes" to our prayers? Would we even bother to pray for rain if the weather report gave a less than 50-50 chance? So often, we adults think that we have this faith thing all figured out. We go to church. We hear the Word. We live for Jesus. But for all our effort we sometimes forget that faith is not so much about what we do for God. It's all about what God does

In Christ, God has done everything for us. Jesus died for our sins. Jesus fulfilled God's commands. Jesus has made us everything God commanded us to be. We receive all this as a full and complete gift of God. It is by grace, through faith. By this same faith we ask God to fill all our needs; including prayers for rain.

Mission: To provide and maintain the best possible building within our means, for our children's education.

Goals: Identify areas where the current building needs repair and follow up with Church Trustees to see that it's being fixed, as well as exploring options for a new building.

The Building Committee decided that an existing building on a new location option wasn't feasible. To keep the current

building we'd have to at least make the upstairs bathrooms handicap accessible, put in a stair lift and get handicap access from outside for the current building. We'd like to look into building on the South side of the parsonage on land the Church already owns – Chrissy has talked with the Assessor's office of McLeod County and as long as the correct permits, etc. are filed and approved there is a good chance of getting approval from the county to build there. We'd also like to get professional opinions on whether the South site or the current site would be a better fit to build.

Outdoor Service

The Outdoor Service was held on Sunday, July 16 at 10:30 a.m. under the Pavilion at the McLeod County Fairgrounds. A pot-luck followed in the Commercial Building meeting room. The children from Vacation Bible School sang their songs and approximately 250 members were in attendance from Zion Lutheran, Grace Lutheran and St. Peters, Darwin and Immanuel.









Ardis' (Tobison) Hot German Potato Salad

8 red (new) potatoes, unpeeled

8-10 slices bacon, chopped

1 stalk celery, diced

1 medium onion, diced

½ cup sugar

½ teaspoon dry mustard

½ teaspoon (or a little less) Kosher salt

¼ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

2 tablespoons cornstarch

½ cup apple cider vinegar

½ cup cold water

Cook potatoes until almost tender. Cool, peel and slice into crock pot. Fry the bacon until translucent. Add the celery and onions and fry until bacon is crisp and brown. Mix the vinegar, water, mustard, salt, pepper, sugar and cornstarch thoroughly. Pour mixture into bacon pan. Cook over low heat, stirring until thickened. Pour over potatoes and toss lightly. Cook on low for 2-3 hours. Serves 6. May be easily doubled or tripled.
