The Lord Hears Their Cry

The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry; the righteous cry out and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.

Psalm 34:15,17

A survey asked young people what physical characteristic they noticed first in members of the opposite sex. People gave all kinds of answers. But one clear winner emerged. The eyes. People noticed the eyes first. The reason is simple. Everyone wants to see if those eyes are looking back. We are most interested in people who are interested in us. We feel most loved by people who pay attention to us and listen to our concerns. Who else is interested in you? God. The Bible says that God watches over his people and he listens to their cry for help. His eyes and ears are on them constantly. Have you ever cried out to God and

asked him for help? Did he answer right away and deliver you from all your troubles? At the moment of trouble this verse gives us the promise of God. He will answer our cry because he keeps his eyes on us. But it also raises an important question. Who is righteous in the sight of God? Who can lay hold of this incredible promise? When compared with God, no human being is truly righteous. But most of the time we don't think much about our lack of righteousness. However, when trouble comes knocking we suddenly remember the ways we have broken God's law. It's then we start to wonder if we have any right to expect God's help.

Only in Jesus can we be righteous. He has washed and cleansed from all our sins. He has given us the perfect holiness and righteousness that God requires. And by faith in Jesus we lay hold of this promise that God is watching and listening. He will hear when we call. He will deliver us from trouble. This is most certainly true.


