Church Fellowship

The teaching about Church Fellowship raises many questions for members in our synod. For one thing, it makes us stand out from other church bodies and other believers. In the past, every church body observed differences of fellowship. That has changed dramatically in the last few decades. Today most Christians look at doctrinal differences as not being very important. For another thing, we ourselves have a fuzzy understanding of what this teaching asks of us. We have lots of questions about what is "allowed" when it comes to interacting with other Christians.

We must realize that the word "fellowship" has three different aspects. First, all believers have a spiritual fellowship with God and with each other through faith in Jesus. Some writers have called this "Christian Fellowship." Second, there is a doctrinal fellowship between believers who have the same confession of faith. In this sense, members of other WELS churches are in fellowship with us because they believe the same as us. Third, we have fellowship that is expressed by joint activities. Our annual outdoor worship service expresses the unity of the four churches who put it on every year.

We believe in the unit concept of church fellowship. That means all expressions of church fellowship require the same level of doctrinal agreement, namely agreement in all the doctrines taught in the Bible. In other words, we can't give anyone permission to ignore something the Bible says. Where God has spoken in his Word all people are bound

to obey. And if someone has a different opinion, fine. But then we can't pretend to have unity with them. We only have true unity when we agree based on the true teachings of God's Word.

Notice what we are NOT saying! We are NOT saying that only WELS Christians will go to heaven. All those who trust in Jesus as their Savior from sin will inherit eternal life. But errors in doctrine always put that faith in danger. So we can't just wallpaper over differences. We must always testify to the truth and urge people to believe it.

When non-WELS Christians visit our church, we don't make them sit in the hallway. We welcome them to come and hear what the Bible says. But we ask them not to receive communion, because that meal is a special expression of unity and one-ness in Christ. When non-WELS Christians attend our school, we don't give them equal time to express alternate views on baptism or Lord's Supper or Church Fellowship. We teach them the truth as we understand it. Parents understand this when they enroll their children. The same concept applies to offerings and financial support. Anyone may give an offering or a gift. But they must understand they are supporting what we teach and preach.

Church fellowship means "working together for the truth." (3 John 8) And it means "we cannot do anything against the truth, but only for the truth." (2 Corinthians 13:8) May God help us to apply this teaching faithfully and lovingly.

The church services are now **live** streamed Sunday mornings on Facebook.



At Immanuel Lutheran School & Children of Grace Preschool We started out the school fundraising project with the same idea as Jonathan in 1 Samuel 14. "Let's take action and see what the Lord will provide." Over the course of the campaign, God's people have committed over \$800,000 to this project. This is strong response! And each believer who made a commitment did so trusting the Lord to provide for our needs and enable us to give the generous offering we promised. We give thanks for the faith and love of each of you. Please continue to pray for this project and the school ministry in general.

So what's happening now? First, a few donor conversations are still going on. We have been talking with a some individual donors who support the school but didn't get the chance to participate in the main campaign. So we expect our pledged total to increase a little bit.

Second, we are waiting for money to come in. We cannot begin any conversations about financing until we have at least some money in hand. The promised gifts will be coming over the course of three years. And every donor gets to decide their own schedule for giving. This is best for the donors but makes it hard to know when the money will be available to us.

Third, we need to decide what we can do with the blessings we have. We may need to reduce the size of the project or run it in phases or both. But before we have that conversation with the builder, we need to do one more thing. We need to make sure we aren't missing some other opportunity. Is there some other property (with or without buildings) that might meet our needs? We won't know if we don't look. Additionally, Grace, our sister church and partner in this project, has asked the school board to consider if the building owned by Vineyard UMC might be used in some way. So a search committee has been appointed to see what may be available. This committee consists of Steve Wendorff, Chrissy Forcier, Ryan Bushman, and Brian Lokensgard. Contact them if you have a lead!


