It's exciting, isn't it? We've been preparing and working a long time to finally see the walls of the new school being built. It's also a little bit terrifying. This is a big step for us. We have lots of changes happening all at once. Big changes make us wonder: will it still feel the same? When everything looks different, will I still feel like I belong here?

Inside the whirlwind of change, we must remember what stays the same. Hebrews 13:8 says, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." Jesus doesn't change his nature from day to day. He remains our loving and faithful Savior. He hasn't forgotten the awful load of sin he carried for us. He hasn't forgotten what it was like to go down into the grave. Not that he holds it against us. Rather, since he paid such a price to win our salvation, Jesus will not fail to watch over us.



The 60th Annual LWMS Convention has come and gone, but the excitement still lingers. For 282 first-time attendees, it was an especially exciting and, perhaps at times, overwhelming experience. A total of more than 1,200 women and men were in attendance.

*At convention \$93,376.49 got split between Home and World Mission projects chosen by the membership. This is 25% of what our circuits collect over the year.

*That means roughly \$380,000 is given to a variety of other Home and World Mission projects that the circuits themselves choose and send in.

*\$39,781.38 was collected in kids c.a.r.e. offerings and is distributed to a project chosen by the Board and promoted throughout the year. This goes back and forth between Home and World every other year.

*\$65,522.16 was collected onsite during the two convention worship services. (More was sent in with online donations as well.)

*Roughly \$12,000.00 will be given to the World Mission project that has a pressing need (Home Mission next year) from the Endowment Fund.

Now, I don't know what your perception of LWMS is. I like to think that if you know, you know. But if you don't, is almost \$500,000 a year what you picture? And friends, that's just the money part. That's the measureable. It's really so much more!"

Almost half a million for non-budgeted WELS Mission needs! (\$478,821.50) That's only one aspect of support that LWMS does for missions and it's been going on for 60 years!!

Join us to support missions and make plans to come to the convention next year in Sioux Falls, SD! Meet the missionaries and hear their stories! Worship services with in the high hundreds to thousands all together at the same time - it is a little taste of what it will be like praising God in heaven. You won't want to miss it.
