Wow, have we been here 9 weeks already? We basically did siding related things all week. You can see from the pictures that it is not a simple siding job. I mentioned last week that there are three colors and three styles. Getting them all in the right place with the correct trim makes it quite interesting. We have a "Special Ops" team bending sill flashing, Z flashing, drip cap, and 2 different sizes of hat channel for all the transitions. After one week we are about  $\frac{3}{4}$  done with the back so it is looking like a 4 week project. We are getting better at it and I think the back is the hardest part because of the terrain we're dealing with and that there are more vents to go around than on the other sides.

The hollow metal door frames were scheduled to arrive this past week, but haven't showed up yet. We need to set some of them before we can complete the siding in some areas.

I also included some pictures of the progress the trades are making with wiring, plumbing, and HVAC.

Nathan Wusterbarth and his wife were here Thursday and Friday for a bit of roof work. We know the roof system works because one cool morning a lot of water came out of the scuppers just from overnight condensation.

Today, September 10, the church is having an official "write on the studs" event after church. The school classes have been coming down during the week to do their signing.
