In spite of the warm weather this week, by God's grace, we were able to nearly finish setting trusses. Of the 250+ total trusses we have 17 30' pieces left and around 64 little ones over the hallway plus 14 on the canopy. My thanks to the crew for hanging in there and doing amazing work on a formidable task!



We started our day after devotion at 6:00 AM to beat the heat a bit. Temperatures are expected to be cooler this week. If we're not too tired, there has also been a game of sheepshead in the evening plus a potluck on Friday night.

Our next project will be sheeting the roof, finish sheeting the sidewalls, and building and sheeting the parapet wall around the perimeter of the roof. You can see on the pictures that that wall is incorporated into the trusses on the front and back but on the end walls we have to build a wall to match the height seen there. When all that is accomplished, Dave Wusterbarth will be able to begin applying the roofing materials. Plumbers have already been drilling holes in the interior walls and the catch basins were installed in the parking lot this week.
