Shameless Audacity

"I tell you, even though he will not get up and give you the bread because of friendship, yet because of your shameless audacity he will surely get up and give you as much as you need." -Luke 11:8.

Jesus taught his disciples to pray with "shameless audacity." They had asked him for instruction on how to pray. In response, Jesus gave them the words of the Lord's Prayer. Then he told them a mini parable about knocking on your friend's door at midnight to ask for a loaf of bread. Most of us have learned to limit our requests. We don't want our friends to get annoyed with us because we ask too much or too frequently. Plus we have the understanding that anything others do for us comes with a social obligation to do something for them. We have a finely tuned awareness of who is getting more or giving more in our relationships.

Things are different with God. Our relationship to him will always be one-sided. He is always giving more and getting less. This is one of the reasons God wants us to call him "Father." Little children don't worry about a social obligation to their parents. They don't feel embarrassed to ask for the moon or to ask every few minutes. Children are shameless in holding their hands out for more. God wants us to act the same way in our prayer lives. Bring him your needs, wants, and requests. Ask more of God than you would ever ask of any person. Hold out your hand again and again for God to fill it up with blessings. When he sent Jesus to take away our sin, God already gave up more than we could ask or imagine. (Who would ever think that God would take our guilt and make it his own?) So come before the Lord in prayer. Ask him to fill all your needs.






Church Decorating

The last BfC trailer left our parking lot on its way to another project in Neenah, Wisconsin. The electric hookups will get taken down. Our teacherage is still set up for BfC volunteers.









Hi Volunteers, As promised, Jeff Pinske and I were back for a bit this week to hang the 7 exterior classroom doors and install temporary locks on them. We were assisted by faithful Allan Duesterhoeft and Abigail Polzin, a member of the Kingdom Workers board. The doors were mostly needed to contain the warmth within the building, as temperatures here have cooled off considerably this week. The week started at 90 degrees and I don't think we reached 50 yesterday plus we had a strong cold northwest wind. The large "storefront doors" are to be installed on Monday, October 9th and then the building should finally be secure. For warranty reasons, the heating system can't be turned on until all of the drywall sanding and painting is done so the heat within the building needs to be contained. The drywall hangers are probably half done and left for a few days for another project. Both the hangers and tapers are scheduled to be there on Monday to proceed with finishing up the drywall. For the 12 or so of you who have indicated interest in returning in November to finish it up, our new super, Phil, thinks we'll be able to hang the interior doors early November and that accessories like handicap grab bars and toilet partitions will probably be late November after all the ceramic tile is in place.
