Led by the Spirit

The Psalms make a similar request over and over. "Lead me, Lord." "Teach me." "Guide me." "Show me the right path." These are all good and proper prayers for Christians to use every day. But we wonder what kind of guidance to expect. Psalm 143:10 gives a good example. It says, "May your good Spirit lead me on level ground." Should we expect God to guide us in our choice between Arby's or Culver's for lunch? What about something more serious like, "Should I go to college or start an apprenticeship to become a plumber?" "Should I get married or go on a mission trip?" These are important questions. Will God help us answer them?

If we look more closely at the Bible passages, we will notice they all have something in common. They are all asking for moral guidance to live in a way that pleases God. The first part of Psalm 143:10 says, "Teach me to do your will, for you are my God." Psalm 25:5 says, "Guide me in your truth and teach me." The Holy Spirit lives in God's people. He influences our hearts to know what is right and love what is good. Believers have new desires, new affections, and new understanding of God's will. All these things have been promised by God. And if we lack in any area we should ask him to lead us, guide us, and teach us. We should seek wisdom in the Word of God because that is where God promised to speak to us.

With regard to the other questions of life, we should not get ourselves twisted up looking for God to make decisions for us. God has not decided if you should get married first or go on a mission trip. He has not predestined you to be a plumber or a college grad. Rather, God rejoices to see what you will decide to do. How will your renewed heart rejoice to serve him? How will your renewed mind bring glory to his name? Yes, God knows the answer already. He knows all things, even the things to come. And he rejoices to see how you will respond to his goodness and grace.

So be led by the Spirit. Love what is good. Desire what is pure and holy. Know what God teaches in his Word. And feel safe in the knowledge that whatever you choose to do will please God. *Pastor Eugene DeVries*



2023 was an exciting year for Immanuel Grace Lutheran School located in rural Hutchinson, Minnesota. After several years of fun-raising and careful planning, we were able to break ground on a new Christian Day School in the spring of the year. Our old building served us well for many years. But since our Lord has blessed us with several consecutive years of increasing enrollment, we finally outgrew our existing facility.

Construction on our new school began late in the spring. God blessed us with good weather and only minimal delays, so construction remained on schedule through the summer and fall. We were especially thankful that Builders For Christ selected our school as one of the building projects they would work on this year. It was great to have brothers and sisters in Christ from Minnesota and around the country come and help us. Their efforts helped keep our project on schedule and saved us a considerable amount of money on labor costs. We also enjoyed have BFC volunteers join us for worship and Bible study while they were working among us. Hutchinson Pastors DeVries and Tobison preparing to speak at school's dedication.

By the grace of our Lord, we were able to complete construction on the new building during the final days of 2023. A large group of volunteers from our school families and members of Grace and Immanuel congregations moved everything from the old school to the new building in a single day. The first week of 2024 was spent setting up our classrooms and getting everything ready for the first day of school. On Sunday, January 7 we held a dedication of our new school and an open house so everyone could come together and see our new facility. The first day of classes was Monday, January 8. All 75 of our students were on hand the first day. In addition to daily classes, we offer before and after school care in our new facility. We are hoping to begin a daycare program in the near future. The capacity of our new building is about 140 students, so we have plenty of room to grow in the future. Thanks be to God for his many blessings to us.

All of us at Immanuel Grace Lutheran School would like to thank all the volunteers from Builders For Christ who helped us in so many ways to make our plans for a new school into reality. May our Lord continue to bless and keep all of you as you continue to use your talents to serve our Lord.
