OPENING DIALOGUE

M: Christ is risen!

C: He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

M: Jesus Christ was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

C: Since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God.

M: Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

C: In all things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

M: Death has been swallowed up in victory.

C: Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

M: Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil, or fade.

C: This inheritance is kept in heaven for us.

M: Jesus is the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in him will live, even though they die.

C: And those who live by believing in him will never die.

M: I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand on the earth.

C: I myself will see him with my own eyes—I, and not another.

M: Since you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.

C: When Christ, who is our life, appears, we will appear with him in glory.

M: Why do you look for the living among the dead?

C: He is not here; he has risen!

M: This is the day the Lord has made.

C: Let us rejoice and be glad in it.

M: Christ is risen!

C: He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

SECOND READING – 1 Corinthians 15:19-26

¹⁹ If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied. ²⁰ But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. ²² For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. ²³ But each in turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him. ²⁴ Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power. ²⁵ For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. ²⁶ The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

GOSPEL – Mark 16:1-8

When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?"

⁴But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. ⁵ As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.

⁶ "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. ⁷ But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you."

⁸ Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid.
